

2020 CALIFORNIA CHARDONNAY



## **WINEMAKER'S NOTES:**

2020 started off with very little rain fall in California. This in turn led to an exceptionally dry and moderately cool winter. These two factors resulted in a late start to the growing season. The Spring months were mild with a few warm days in June. The crop set nicely, although bloom and set were slow to pass through to the finish line. The beginning of June brought a few unseasonably warm days that pushed maturity back onto a more normal timeline. Harvest began within a few days of our average start date in the third week of August.

This wine pairs beautifully with herb-baked chicken, grilled or poached salmon, mac & cheese, or a Caesar salad. Delightful by the glass on its own.

## WINE DESCRIPTION:

This wine is a bright gold color with aromas of Meyer lemon, pear and honeysuckle, with hints of vanilla and cinnamon. Delicious flavors of ripe pear and Meyer lemon with hints of caramel. The texture is rich and round, with a crisp finish.
